Article 60 of EDUCATION CODE: CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS :

The following acts and conduct on the part of the students will amount to misconduct:

- (i) Misbehaviour towards teachers or any other employee of the school
- (ii) Internationally disturbance of classes.
- (iii) Absence from classes without the permission of the teacher/Vice-Principal / Principal.
- (iv) Bullying / intimidation of others.
- (v) Eye-teasing / misbehaviour towards girl-students.
- (vi) Damaging / disfiguring school property.
- (vii) Propagating a strike / disruption of classes.
- (viii) Association with brand or Organizations.
- (ix) Propagating communal / caste feeling amongst the students.
- (x) Indulging in physical violence in any manner.
- (xi) Disobeying lawful orders of the teacher / vice - Principal / Principal
- (xii) Bringing unauthorized people / articles inside the school including Mobile Phones.
- (xiii) Theft/pilferage of school / students' property.
- (xiv) Prohibition from using social media against teachers. administration and the school
- (xv) Indulging in acts of moral turpitude, disrespecting National Flag & National Anthem.
- (xvi) Any behaviour unbecoming of a student.

In above acts of misconduct. Principal shall take suitable action as per observation of the disciplinary committee depending on the gravity of the misconduct, which may include:

- (i) Oral / written warnings to the student and parents.
- (ii) Suspension from attending classes / school for a specified period.
- (iii) Recovery of loss to school property
- (iv) Issue of Transfer Certificate
- (v) Expulsion / rustication from school.

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The school is a co-educational (mixed) English Medium Higher Secondary School established in 1930 and administered by the Indian Railways for the education of the children of railway employees and affiliated to the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations (CISCE), New Delhi. The School runs from class-I to class-XII through the medium of English. Hindi and Bengali are taught second and third languages inter-changeably. The school prepares the students to appear in ICSE Examination (Class-X) and ISC Examination (Class XII). In ISC there are two streams-Science and Commerce.

ADMISSION & WITHDRAWAL

Admission in the school is strictly made as per the Govt. rules and guidelines given by the CPO/GRC and Sr. DPO/KGP. Some main points are as follows.

1. Admission is open for the wards of Rly. employees only. Notification is given in the month of January. The normal age for admission in class 1 is 6 Yrs. (31st March in the Academic Year)
2. Admission in classes II to IX and XI is made according to existing vacancies. In these classes, applications are invited from the serving railway employees if vacancy exists. Notice for this purpose is given in advance on the school notice board and website. Admission is granted preferably to students of English medium background.
3. During admission, parents have to show original Birth Certificate of the child and submit xerox copy of the same.

4. In case of migration from another state, the T.C. must be countersigned by the competent authority of the state otherwise admission will not be granted.
5. Guardians are requested to fill in the admission form with utmost accuracy as on change in the name of the student, father's name and date of birth, is permitted as per the rules.
6. Transfer Certificate will be issued to a child (a) on receipt of an application of withdrawal from the parents / guardian or (b) found guilty of indiscipline or misconduct.
7. Application for withdrawal of student should be submitted within 15 days of publication of the result to avail the exemption of Student Development Fees.

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Hair Style

Girls of classes VI to X will make two plaits and classes XI and XII girls will make one plait.

Boys : Hair should be kept evenly short and decently arranged so that they have a student-like appearance. Clean shave is compulsory for all the boys of classes XI & XII.

For Slow Learners, below average and average students. Classes are conducted during School hours.

ACTIVITIES

The school provides wide array of various competitions. Co Curricular and extra curricular activities. like debate, quiz, extempore, music, dance, handicraft etc. The objective is to create a platform to showcase the talent of the students, Workshops are periodically organised to enlighten and empower the students for global challenges.

Each house is headed by a House Captain selected by the Senior teachers. Each house is under the supervision and control of a teachers.

DISCIPLINE

Special attention given to ensure a high standard of morality and discipline in the school, Regularity in school attendance and punctuality in school assignment is a must for each student Habitual, irregular attendance, late arrival. Dirty indecent uniforms, indiscipline etc, justify immediate suspension of the child from the school till further order.

Periodic reports given by the class-teacher concerned will inform the parents about the progress and activities of their wards. These report are to be signed by the parents and returned to the teacher concerned with their comments. Children suffering from infections diseases will not be allowed to attend the school unless they submit a fir certificate by a Rail way doctor.

EVALUATION AND PROMOTION

To make the evaluation a continuous process, the school holds regular tests and examinations. There will be two exams. Half yearly & Annual from I to XII Science / Commerce Pre Boards is for Class X and XII students. Promotion to a higher class is made on whole years average. No promotion is granted to a child whose attendance in the school is less than 70% except those children who have been granted leave by the school on the basis of sufficient grounds to the fullest satisfaction of the school authority. Passing in English is compulsory criteria for promotion to next higher class. During the holidays and vacation the school office hours will be as per the direction given by the Kharagpur Division of S. E. Rly. In the last working date of a month, classes will be over after 7th period.

LIBRARY RULES

The library is open on all working days Children reading in classes VI and above may borrow books according to the time and day fixed for each class. Only one book is issued to a child at a time for one week. Books can be borrowed or returned only on the respective class days If any defect is noticed while borrowing a book, it should be brought to the notice of the librarian immediately otherwise the borrower will have to either replace the book with a new one or to pay the cost of the book, Staff members may borrow three books at a time maximum for a fortnight only. Books once borrowed can be reissued on request. Strict silence is to be maintained in the library.

LEAVE

- 1) Leave of absence is granted to the students only on sufficient grounds.
- 2) No leave is granted in such reasons as urgent work, not feeling well etc. The reasons, must be specified clearly for sickness. Doctor's certificate is acceptable.
- 3) The parents must make an application for leave of absence addressed to the Head of the Institution through the concerned. Class-Teacher and a brief note must be made with the signature of the parents/guardian in the Leave Record' column of the school diary.
- 4) If a child requires a leave of absence for 7 days or more continuously a prior written intimation has to be submitted to the principal through the class teacher
- 5) Leave will only be granted based on the note of the class teachers.
- 6) No leave will be granted during the exam period.

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Parent's Signature**RULES OF THE SCHOOL FOR THE STUDENTS**

- 1) Children must reach school at 7:45 a.m. and attend the prayer at 7:50 a.m. Or at the time whenever called upon ter do so. Late comers may be sent back home.
2. Regular and punctual attendance in daily Assembly/Prayer is a must for all irrespective of caste, creed and religion.
3. Students must be in neat and proper school uniform otherwise they may be sent back home at their own risk.
4. They will bring with them in thair school bag all the text books & exercise books covered according to the timetable. Students are advised to bring steel glass instead of single use water bottle or may bring metallic cool water bottle of any make The y are themselves responsible for the safety of their belongings.
5. No books, periodicals, pamphlets or anything of objectionable nature should be brought to the school. If detected, the articles will be confiscated and will not be returned. Such children will also be punished.
6. Cleanliness of the class rooms and the school compound is the duty of each student No child is allowed to throw rubbish, waste paper. etc, in the school premises.
7. Participation in games and sports, co-curricular and extra curricular activities and in the Social Useful. and Productive Works is mustt for all students.

8. If a child is selected in present the school in the co curricular and extra curricular activities and sent out of Santragachi, he/she will have to go with a teacher with a teacher with me objection certificate from their guardian, the child fails to attend such activities, it will be treated us in act of indiscipline: No child will take part in any outside competitions, in the name of the school without prior intimation.
9. No child is allow to go out of his/her classroom without the permission of the Chas Teacher/Subject Teacher. Similarly no student will go out of the school compound, even during the recess without the permission of the Head of the Institution.
10. They are warned against buying any food material from unauthorised vendor.
11. No collection of money will be made by a student without the permissions of the Class Teacher.
12. It is compulsory for all students to sit a all tests and examinations failing which they will be denied promotion in the next higher class.
13. Promotion of a student is at the discretion of the Principal. A child may be detained for misconduct / poor attendance even if he/she passes the written examination.
14. Student will plant a tree within school premises on his/her birthday.

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- 1) Parents and Guardians are requested to co-operate with the school authorities
 - i) by motivating their wards to be regular and punctual in attendance:
 - ii) by insisting on the neatness and cleanliness of the school uniforms, textbooks, exercise books, personal appearance etc. of their wards:
 - iii) by seeing that wards are diligent in their home works, preparation of lessons and self study:
 - iv) by providing opportunities at home for self expression of their experiences and ideas.
2. They are requested to send their wards with sufficient tiffin and water. No money should be given to the children to buy tiffin from outside, Children will not be allowed to leave the school premises during Recess Tiffin Time.
3. They are requested not to enter into the class-rooms of their wards during the teaching hours. All dealings must be conducted through the Principal from 11 a.m. to 12 p.m. If necessary, they may come to school with prior permission.
4. Sometimes the school may require the personal presence of the parents/guardians. It is obligatory on their part to come to school on such occasions.
5. The school diary is a link between the parents and the school. They are advised to see the entries made in diary in the Regulatory Record and Home Assignment columns of the Particular day as also the Parent Teacher Communication, Remark columns daily and sign them. They may communicate with the school by making entries in the columns meant for them.

6. Canvassing for illegal gains or putting pressure on the School Authorities for undue favour will be viewed seriously and the school may recommend departmental disciplinary action against such guardians.
7. The school is a social institution where the child spends only one fourth of his/her time of a day. For the rest of the time he/she is at home. The parents/guardians will help their wards in inculcating the desired habits, positive thinking, self respect and the development of integrated personality.
8. Mobile phone and Motor bikes are not at all allowed for the students. Disciplinary action will be taken against those who will be found guilty.
9. Please inform the school authorities in advance whenever your ward is supposed to take leave for more than a week.
10. The names of the detained student may be retained in their respective class register for two consecutive years only. For special cases it may be considered for one more year.
